## Field survey to focus on correcting U.S. 50 elevation at spot in Reno County


A field survey for a proposed project to correct the elevation of U.S. 50 just east of Brandy Lake Road in Reno County is scheduled to start around Monday, April 5.

The field survey – estimated to be completed by May 21 -- will gather information needed for the detailed design of the proposed improvement.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
