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Shoulder resurfacing on I-70 begins Monday in Saline County

Beginning Monday, Apr. 19, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a HMA overlay with a chip seal on the shoulders of I-70.

Work on eastbound and westbound I-70 will begin at the Saline/Lincoln county line and continue east about 8 miles.

Traffic will be reduced to one 16-foot lane at a reduced speed through the work zone. Drivers should expect minimal delays, not exceeding five minutes.

APACShears Division, of Hutchinson is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$2.5 million project to be completed in early June, weather permitting.
