I-470 lanes reduced in Topeka starting April 22

The northbound and southbound lanes of I-470 between the Huntoon Street off ramp and Wanamaker Road in Topeka will be reduced to two lanes starting Thursday, April 22, weather permitting.

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, the lane reduction is necessary for bridge repair work. Concrete barriers, signs and cones will mark the construction area.

Bettis Asphalt & Construction of Topeka is the contractor on the \$417,000 project. Work on the bridge is expected to be completed in early July.
