Resurfacing on K-14 begins today in Jewell County

Today, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a 2" surface recycle and chip seal on K-14 between the U.S. 36/K-14 junction and the Nebraska state line in Jewell County.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through construction. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Dustrol Inc. of Towanda is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$1.25 million project to be completed by September, weather permitting.
