Crack seal work to begin on K-14 in Harper, Kingman counties

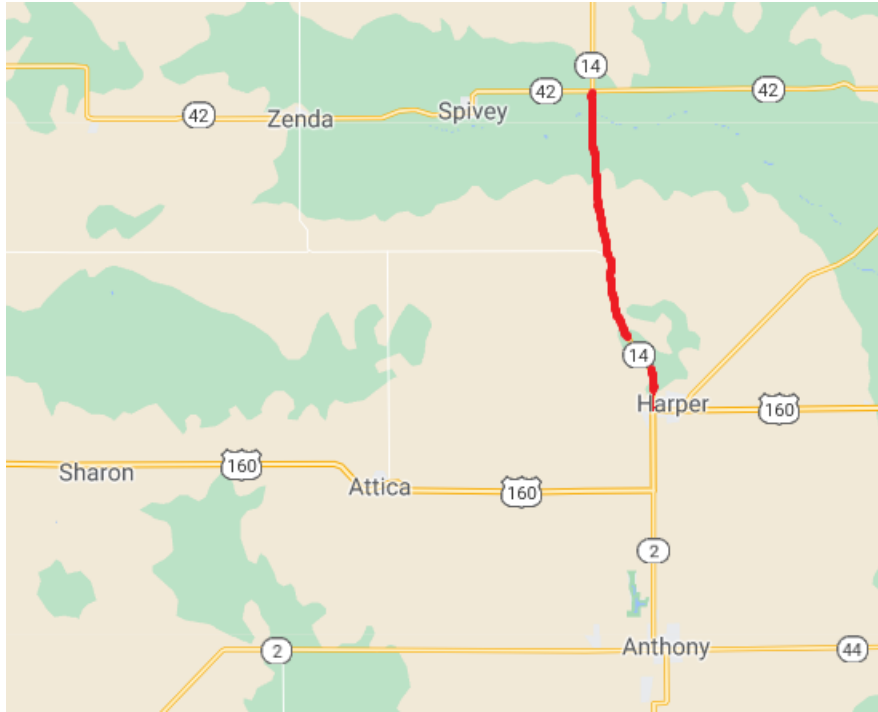
An asphalt crack seal project on K-14 in Harper and Kingman counties is expected to begin around March 1.

The work will be on K-14 from the U.S. 160 junction at Harper north to the K-42 junction in Kingman County. The length is about 20 miles.

During the project – ending around March 29 – traffic will be controlled by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists should be prepared to slow down and stop for the work zone.

Scodeller Construction Inc., of Wixom, Mich., is the prime contractor for the \$94,929 project, overseen by the Kansas Department of Transportation.
