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U.S. 160 road, bridge field survey to start in Comanche County

A field survey for proposed road and bridge improvements on U.S. 160 in Comanche County is scheduled to begin around July 26.


The survey will be on U.S. 160 from the south U.S. 183/U.S. 160/K-1 junction north to Fourth Street in Coldwater. The length is 5.2 miles. The survey will be based on existing alignment.

The field survey – estimated to be completed by Nov. 15 -- will gather information needed for detailed design of the proposed improvements.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.

Michael Selley, P.S., Survey Project Manager, Bureau of Right of Way, will be in charge of this survey for the Kansas Department of Transportation.
