Centerline resurfacing to begin on U.S. 54 in Kiowa County

Starting around Monday, July 19, workers will resurface the centerline on a nearly 14-mile section of U.S. 54 in Kiowa County.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project involves a mill and hot-mix-asphalt overlay on a 2-foot strip on the centerline of U.S. 54 -- from 1 mile east of the Greensburg city limits to the Kiowa/Pratt county line.

The project is expected to be completed around July 31.

During the work, traffic will be controlled by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists should be prepared to stop and expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Venture Corp., of Great Bend, is the primary contractor for the \$459,983 project.
