KDOT highway sign replacement project coming to Kiowa County

A traffic sign replacement project on U.S. 54, U.S. 183 and U.S. 400 in Kiowa County is expected to start around Aug. 9.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project will cover about 35 miles of highway. New signs will be installed at various locations on those three highways. The work is expected to have minimal impact on traffic. The project is estimated to be completed around Oct. 22.
