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\$2.9 million resurfacing of U.S. 50 in Reno County to start soon

A \$2.9 million resurfacing of U.S. 50 in eastern Reno County is expected to begin around July 15.


The Kansas Department of Transportation project involves a mill and hot-mix-asphalt overlay on U.S. 50 just west of Obee Road, on the east side of Hutchinson, to the Reno/Harvey county line, west of Burrton. The length is 8.2 miles.

During the construction, traffic will be restricted to one lane and controlled by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists should be prepared to slow down and stop for the construction zone and face delays of up to 15 minutes.

The project is expected to be completed around mid-August.

APAC Kansas Inc., of Hutchinson, is the primary contractor for the \$2,940,894 project.
