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
Resurfacing on K-9 begins Tuesday in Cloud and Washington counties

On Tuesday, June 22, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a 2" surface recycle and chip seal on K-9 between the east city limits of Concordia and the north city limits of Clifton, work will not include the city of Clyde (see attached map).

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through construction. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Dustrol Inc. of Towanda is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$1.6 million project to be completed in August, weather permitting.
