## Rumble strip project in Butler, Harvey counties to begin soon

A project to install rumble strips at various highway locations in Butler and Harvey counties is expected to start on June 28.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project – installing rumble strips near the edge line – is expected to be completed around July 16.

During the work, traffic will be restricted in some places and minimally affected in others. Also, in some places, traffic will be controlled by flaggers and pilot cars, so motorists should be prepared to slow down and stop.

Surface Preparation Technologies, of New Kingstown, Pa., is the primary contractor for the \$92,304 project.
