Survey to begin Monday in Chase County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a field survey on Monday, Mar. 15 for the detailed design of the proposed bridge replacement on K-177 in Chase County.

The location surveyed is for the K-177 bridge over Rock Creek, located 14.1 miles north of the Butler/Chase County line.

The survey will take place on the existing highway alignment.

KDOT expects the survey to be completed by Apr. 12. Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor.

A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property.
