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## Crack repair will start on U.S. 54 east of Kingman

Crack repair on a 9-mile stretch of U.S. 54 in Kingman County will begin soon.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project is expected to begin around Nov. 22 and be completed around early December.

The work will be on U.S. 54 from the east city limits of Kingman east to the K-14 junction. The length is almost 9 miles.

During the work, traffic will be restricted to one lane and controlled by flaggers and a pilot car, so motorists should be prepared to stop and face delays of up to 15 minutes.

Pavement Pros, of McPherson, is the primary contractor for the \$81,979 project.
