Crack repair coming to U.S. 183 in Kiowa, Edwards counties

Crack repair on about 25 miles of U.S. 183 in Kiowa and Edwards counties will start soon.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project is expected to begin around Nov. 8 and be completed around Nov. 22.

The work will be on U.S. 183 from the U.S. 54 junction, near Greensburg, north to the south city limits of Kinsley.

During the work, traffic will be restricted to one lane and controlled by flaggers and a pilot car, so motorists should be prepared to stop and face delays of up to 15 minutes.

Pavement Pros, of McPherson, is the primary contractor for the \$157,188 project.
