Guardrail project coming to U.S. 54 east of El Dorado

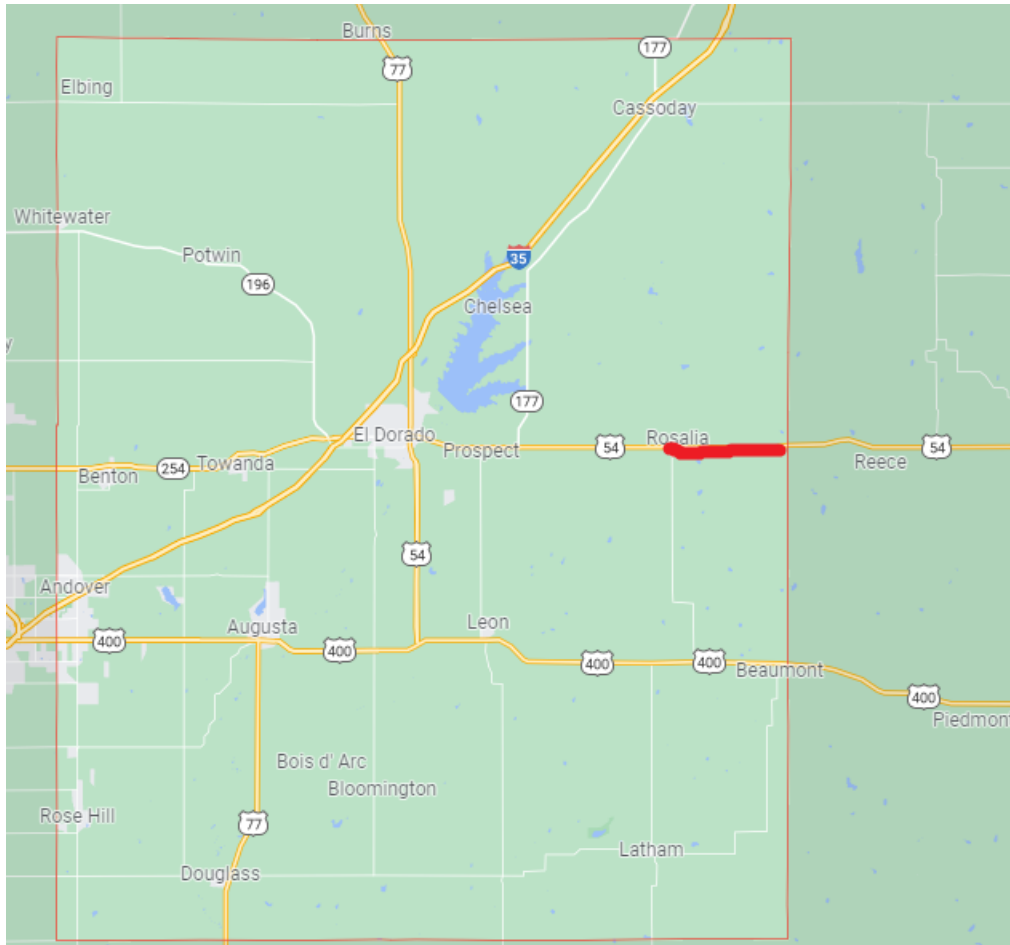
A guardrail replacement project will begin soon on U.S. 54 east of El Dorado.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project will be on a 1.6-mile section of U.S. 54 in eastern Butler County. The work is expected to begin around Nov. 1 and end around early February 2022.

During the project, drivers should be prepared for temporary lane closures, shoulder work and a reduced speed.

Bettis Asphalt & Construction Inc., of Topeka, is the primary contractor for the \$722,014 project.
