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\$2.38 million resurfacing on U.S. 50 west of Kinsley begins soon

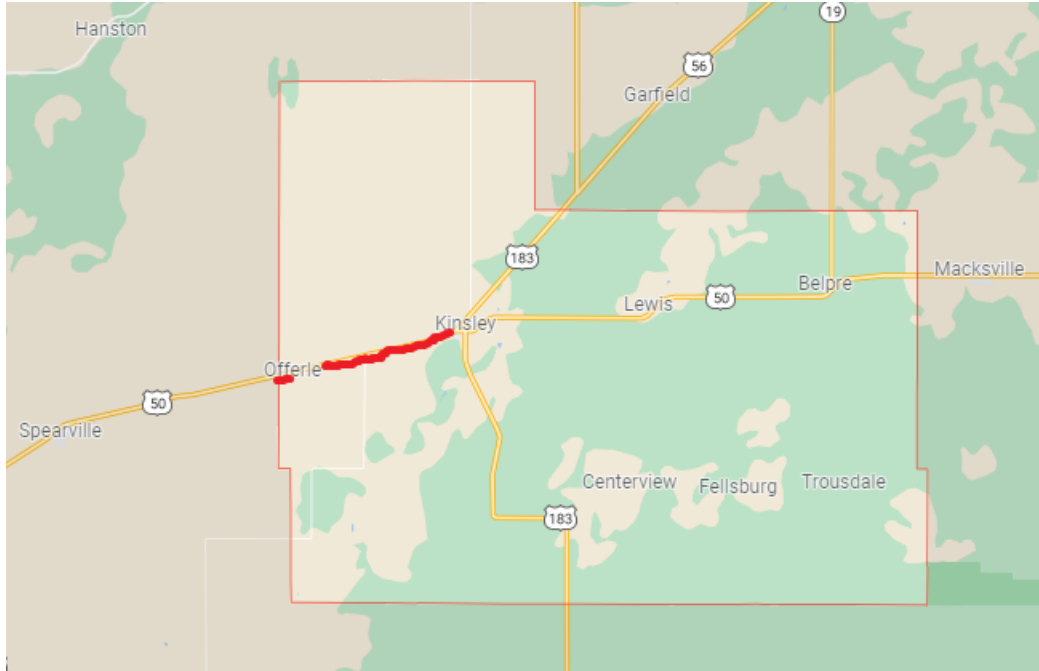
A \$2.38 million mill and overlay on U.S. 50 in Edwards County will start soon.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project involves a mill and hot-mix-asphalt overlay on U.S. 50 from the Ford/Edwards county line east to the Kinsley west city limits. The length is almost 8.5 miles.

During the work, to begin around Oct. 11 and end around mid-November, traffic on that section will be restricted to one lane and controlled by a pilot car and flaggers. Motorists should be prepared to slow down and stop and face delays of up to 15 minutes.

The primary contractor for the \$2,382,591 project is Venture Corp., of Great Bend.
