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Resurfacing project underway in Clay County

The Kansas Department of Transportation has begun a chip seal on U.S. 24 in Clay County.

Work on U.S. 24 will extend east approximately 20 miles from the Clay/Cloud county line to the Clay/Riley county line.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through construction. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Vance Brothers Inc. of Kansas City, Mo., is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$707,890 project to be completed by October, weather permitting.
