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Resurfacing project to begin Tuesday in Washington County

Beginning Tuesday Sept. 21, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a chip seal on U.S. 36 in Washington County.

Work on U.S. 36 will extend east from approximately nine miles east of the east city limits of Washington to the Washington/Marshall county line.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane for four miles on the east end of the project and controlled by flaggers and a pilot car for 0.5 miles of the west end of the project. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Vance Brothers Inc. of Kansas City, Mo., is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$360,630 project to be completed by October, weather permitting.
