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## Resurfacing project begins Friday in Ellsworth County

Beginning Friday, Sept. 3, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a chip seal on K-156 in Ellsworth County.

Work on K-156 will extend north about 10.5 miles from the north city limits of Ellsworth to I-70.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through construction. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Vance Brothers Inc. of Kansas City, Mo., is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$504,466 project to be completed in September, weather permitting.
