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Resurfacing begins Monday in Geary County


Beginning Monday, Aug. 16, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a mill and overlay on K-57 and U.S. 77 in Geary County.

Work on K-57 will extend from the K-57/K-244 junction north over the Milford Reservoir Dam to the North US-77/K-57 junction. Work on U.S. 77 will extend from just south of the K-57 south junction to just north of the south junction. (See attached map.)

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through construction. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Shilling Construction Co. of Manhattan is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$1.46 million project to be completed by October, weather permitting.
