Storm water detention project begins today in Ellsworth County

Beginning Tuesday, Sept. 7, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a grading project to construct storm water detention basins in Ellsworth.

Work is in the northeast and southeast quadrants of the K-14/K-140 intersection, stay alert to trucks entering and exiting the roadway.

Cahoj Earthmoving Inc., of Atwood, is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$395,602 project to be completed in November, weather permitting.
