Daily Traffic Information for July 19, 2019

All planned closures and scheduled work are weather permitting and subject to change.

JOHNSON COUNTY

Maintenance Activity: Short-Term

<u>I-435:</u>

Southbound will have the right lane closed from 87th to 95th from 9AM-3PM for spray patching.

Northbound will have the left two lanes closed from 95th to Midland Dr from 9AM-3PM for spray patching.

Maintenance Activity: Long-Term

<u>I-435:</u>

Southbound will have the right lane closed from Midland Rd. to 87th St. for pavement repairs. The center lane will have daily lane closures from 9AM-4PM

Construction Activity: Short-Term Closures

I-35: Project 35-46 KA 5126-01 Thursday Night

Northbound will have the two left lanes closed from 135th to 119th from 8PM to 5AM for asphalt paving.

Construction Activity: Long-Term Closures

135: Project 35-105 KA 4939-01

Beginning Monday, July 15, Kansas Department of Transportation will perform bridge repairs on U.S.69 over Merriam Lane and Turkey Creek in Wyandotte County, including replacing approach pavement, replacing expansion joints and repairing and replacing bearings. Northbound and southbound U.S.69 will be reduced to one lane in each direction from I-35 to Merriam Lane through the duration of the project. The project is estimated to be completed by January 2020.

K10: Project 10-46 KA 4877-01

The westbound entrance ramps from Renner Blvd to K-10 and Ridgeview Rd to K-10 will be closed and will remain closed through the duration of the project.

Westbound K-10 will be reduced to one lane of traffic from Ridgeview Rd to Woodland Rd through the duration of the project.

Traffic wanting to access westbound K-10 from Renner or Ridgeview should use College Blvd or Prairie Star Pkwy.

The project is expected to be completed by late July.

K10: Project 10-46 KA 5000-01

Eastbound and westbound K-10 from Douglas County to K-7 will have daily lane and ramp closures throughout the duration of the project which is expected to be completed by mid-September for an asphalt mill and overlay.

135: Project 35-46 KA 3083-01

Beginning 4/8/19 Sunflower Rd at the I-35 interchange will be closed to thru-traffic and will remain closed for the duration of the project.

The entrance and exit ramps to and from I-35 will close for intermittent periods through the duration of the project. Updates on the ramp closures will be made prior to the closures. During the bridge demolition I-35 traffic will be detoured on the exit/entrance ramps. The demolition is tentatively scheduled for the night of Friday, August 2nd through the morning of Saturday, August 3rd.

Beginning 5/14/19 the northbound exit and entrance ramps to and from Sunflower Rd will be closed long term.

The project is expected to be completed by late December.

135: Project 35-46 KA 4782-01

Beginning Friday, June 7, 2019, work will begin on I-35 to lengthen the bridges over the BNSF railroad (between Old US-56 and 151st Street). Northbound will be reduced to one lane and southbound will be reduced to two lanes through the duration of the project from Lone Elm Rd to old US-56 Hwy. The project is estimated to be completed by mid-November.

US69: Project 69-46 KA 4876-01

Southbound US-69 will be reduced to one lane in the vicinity of 151st Street for bridge repairs. The project is expected to be completed by mid-August.

US69: Project 69-46 KA 5001-01 & 5002-01

Beginning 6/27/19 northbound and southbound US-69 will be reduced to one lane nightly from 7:30PM-5:30AM from 103rd Street to the Blue Valley split for pavement patching followed by a mill and overlay. Exit and entrance ramps will be closed intermittently during those same times. The project is expected to be completed by late July.

135: Project 35-46 KA 5126-01

Night work on a concrete patching, milling and asphalt overlay repair project on I-35 will begin on Monday, May 6, weather permitting, from 95th Street south to 135th Street.

Lane reductions will take place from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. throughout the project area. Some Sunday work may be necessary. Ramps will be closed intermittently for milling and overlay during the repair work, and there will be no signed detours. Motorists are urged to allow extra time to their travel schedule or use an alternate route.

The work is scheduled to be completed by late October.

WYANDOTTE COUNTY

Daily Closures

Maintenance

US Highway 69 (18th St.) northbound will have the right lane closed from Metropolitan Avenue to Kansas Avenue from approximately 12:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. for bridge inspection. This closure is in effect for Friday, July 19, 2019.

Long-Term Closures

I-635

Starting on Friday night (6 pm) June 28, work will begin to repair the northbound and southbound I-635 bridge over Speaker Road (just north of K-32). Traffic in both directions will be reduced to one lane from 6:00 p.m. – 10:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday evenings for barrier wall placement. Traffic in both directions will then be reduced to two lanes utilizing the shoulder. This will also require the closures of the ramps from eastbound and westbound I-70 to southbound I-635, and the ramps from eastbound and westbound K-32 to northbound I-635 for the duration of the project. The detours for these closures will be via I-70 to the north and I-35 to the south then to 18th St/US 69 to K-32. This closure will be in effect through November 23, 2019.

I-70

I-70, both eastbound and westbound, will have alternating lane closures reducing traffic to one lane overnight from 7:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m. between 38th St. and the I-70/I-670 interchange. This closure will be in effect through July 19, 2019.

Lewis and Clark Viaduct

Westbound I-70 will be closed past Broadway Blvd (in Missouri NW corner of the downtown loop) to 3rd St in Kansas City, Kansas for bridge replacement. This closure will be in effect through December 31, 2019.

Ramps from 5th St, Beardsley Rd, Independence Ave at Delaware Ave and I-35 to Westbound I-70 (in Missouri) will be closed for the Westbound I-70 bridge replacement. This closure will be in effect through December 31, 2019.

Ramps from Westbound I-70 to Minnesota Ave, Washington Blvd, and Fairfax Trafficway will be closed for the Westbound I-70 bridge replacement. This closure will be in effect through December 31, 2019.
