I-35 Gateway Yellow Project Lane & Ramp Closures

OVERNIGHT CLOSURES! EXPECT DELAYS! Southbound right lane will be closed from I-435 to 119th Street for setting temporary concrete safety barrier beginning at 8:00 p.m. on Monday, June 4 and reopening to all traffic at 5:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 5; then again from 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 5 and reopening to all traffic at 5:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 6. (I-35 Gateway Yellow Project) Project work is scheduled to be completed on Wednesday, June 6.

OVERNIGHT CLOSURES! EXPECT DELAYS! Eastbound and westbound I-435 to southbound I-35 ramps and southbound I-35 to 119th Street ramp will be closed for setting temporary concrete safety barrier beginning at 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 6 and reopening to all traffic at 5:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 7; then again from 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 7 and reopening to all traffic at 5:00 a.m. on Friday, June 8. Message boards will alert drivers to the marked detours. (I-35 Gateway Yellow Project) Project work is scheduled to be completed on Friday, June 8.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs, and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through the project work zone.
