

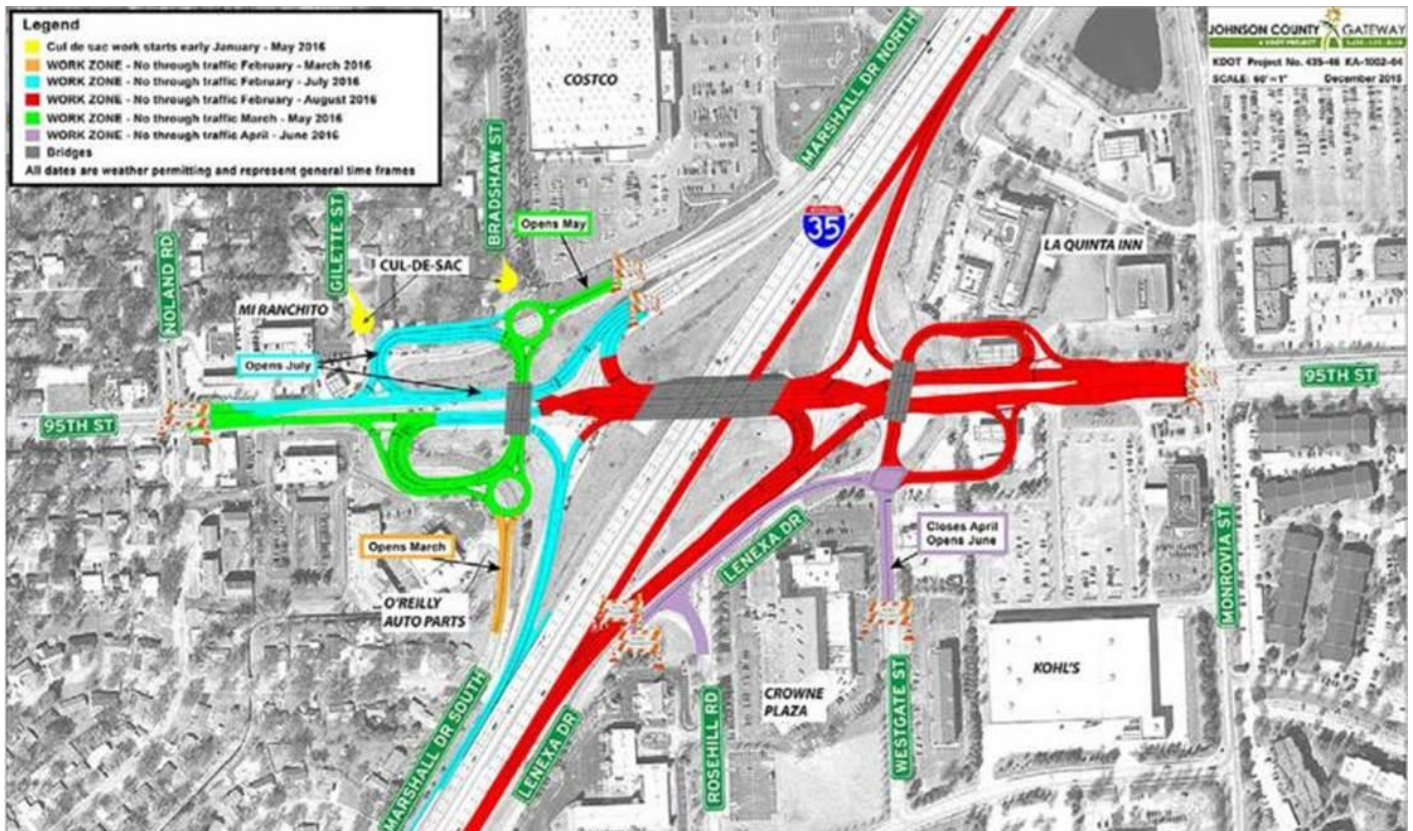

Bradshaw & Gillette Streets at Marshall Drive Intersections

RESCHEDULED START DATE! PERMANENT FULL ROADWAY

CLOSURES: Bradshaw and Gillette Streets at Marshall Drive intersections will be **CLOSED** permanently beginning **Wednesday, January 6, 2016** ~~Monday, January 4, 2016~~ for utility and cul-de-sac construction work. Both local streets will be closed at the Marshall Drive intersections permanently as crews complete construction work to turn both intersections into cul-de-sacs as part of the overall 95th Street and I-35 Diverging Diamond Interchange Project. Gillette Street is currently a one-way southbound roadway between Marshall Drive

and 94th Place, and with this Marshall Drive intersection closure it will become a two-way roadway permanently. The cul-de-sac construction work will be completed in **May 2016**, weather permitting.

Advance message boards will alert drivers to the full roadway closures. Traffic will be directed via signage, cones and barricades through the project work zone.
