I-435 Traffic shift changes for the weekend

The Kansas Department of Transportation will be doing traffic shifts throughout the next couple of weeks along I-435 between Metcalf and Quivira, in order to put traffic into the winter configuration.

This will entail removing traffic control and putting traffic into the original lanes. In order to accomplish this, KDOT will need to reduce I-435 to one open lane and close ramps throughout the project. The work will take around two weeks. Closures, dates and detours are listed below.

- **Sunday Oct. 29 at 8 a.m. until 8 p.m.** – Re-stripe eastbound I-435 to winter configuration:
 - I-435 eastbound will be reduced to a single lane.
 - U.S. 69 northbound and southbound to eastbound I-435 ramp will be closed. Traffic will detour via I-435 westbound to Lackman Rd. to I-435 eastbound.
 - Quivira Rd. to I-435 eastbound on-ramp will be closed. Traffic will detour via College Blvd. to Metcalf Ave. to I-435 eastbound.
 - Antioch Rd. to I-435 eastbound on-ramp will be closed. Traffic will detour via College Blvd. to Metcalf Ave. to I-435 eastbound.
 - I-435 eastbound to Antioch Rd. exit ramp will be closed. Traffic will detour via Nall Ave. to College Blvd. to Antioch Rd.
 - I-435 eastbound to Metcalf Ave. exit ramp will be closed. Traffic will detour via Nall Ave. to College Blvd. to Metcalf Ave.
