Lewis & Clark Viaduct inspection continues this week

Various ramp and lane closures on the Lewis & Clark Viaduct are continuing this week for scheduled bridge inspection work, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

Wednesday, June 21 - the westbound ramp to Minnesota Avenue and the westbound ramp to I-70 will be reduced to one lane of traffic from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Thursday, June 22 - the westbound ramp to Minnesota Avenue will continue to be reduced to one lane from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Saturday, June 24 – the eastbound ramp to I-70 and the left lane on I-70 will be closed from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Traffic will be detoured onto 3rd Street, Armstrong Avenue and 4th Street.

Sunday, June 25 – the I-70 ramp to eastbound I-70 mainline and the right lane of I-70 will be closed from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Traffic will be detoured on to James Street, Armstrong Avenue and 4th Street.
