Additional ramp and lane closures, Jefferson and Wyandotte counties

Additional ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Jefferson and Wyandotte counties, Thursday, July 23 and Friday, July 24, weather permitting. Traffic on these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

Jefferson County -

For pavement marking, the closures include:

- Single lane closure on U.S. 59, from K-4 moving south to the Oskaloosa southern city limits. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Friday, July 24. Traffic control will include a pilot car operation.

Wyandotte County -


For concrete paving, the closures include:

For KC Scout camera work, the closures include:

- Right lane northbound I-635, just south of Leavenworth Road, will be closed intermittently, Thursday, July 23, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
