## Additional lane closures in Johnson County tonight and tomorrow

Lane closures are scheduled in Johnson County, Wednesday, June 24 and Thursday, June 25, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

For pavement patching to prepare for overlay, the closures include:

- Two right lanes of northbound I-435 closed from K-10 to Midland Drive,

- Northbound on ramp from 87<sup>th</sup> Street to I-435, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Wednesday, June 24.


For asphalt milling and overlay, the closures include:

- Right lane of northbound K-7, from 47<sup>th</sup> Street to the Kansas River, then left lane of southbound K-7, from 43<sup>rd</sup> Street to 67<sup>th</sup> Street, there will also be intermittent ramp closures, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Wednesday, June 24.

For guardrail maintenance, the closures include:

- Left lane westbound K-10, from South Ridgeview Road to Mill Creek, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Thursday, June 25.
