Additional ramp and lane closures, Jefferson and Wyandotte counties

Additional ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Jefferson and Wyandotte counties, Tuesday, July 21 to Sunday, July 26, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

Jefferson County -

For pavement marking, the closures include:

- Single lane closure on U.S. 59, from K-4 moving south to the Oskaloosa southern city limits. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Wednesday, July 22. Traffic control will include a pilot car operation.

Wyandotte County -

For pavement patching, as part of overlay project on I-635, the closures include:


- Ramp southbound I-635 at Merriam Drive, from 10 p.m., Tuesday, July 21 to 5 a.m., Friday, July 24.
- Ramps southbound I-635 to southbound I-35, I-635 to northbound I-35, southbound I-35 to southbound I-635 and northbound I-35 to northbound I-635, from 10 p.m., Tuesday, July 21 to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 26.

For pothole patching, the closures include:


- Alternating lanes eastbound and westbound I-70, from 61st Street to the Missouri State Line, Wednesday, July 22 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Alternating lanes northbound and southbound I-635, from I-70 to the Missouri State Line, Wednesday, July 22, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
