**Additional ramp and lane closures in Wyandotte County**

Additional ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Wyandotte County, Thursday, June 25 to Thursday, July 2, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

For pavement patching, as part of the I-635 overlay project, the closures include:

- Ramp closure southbound I-35 to southbound U.S. 69, 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Thursday, June 25 to Saturday, June 27.
- Ramp closure southbound I-35 to southbound U.S. 69, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, June 29 to Tuesday, June 30.
- Ramp closure northbound U.S. 69 to northbound I-635, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, June 29 to Wednesday, July 1.
- Ramp closure southbound I-35 to northbound I-635, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, June 29 to Thursday, July 2.
- Ramp closure northbound I-635 off ramp to Merriam Lane and the northbound I-635 on ramp from Merriam Lane, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, June 30 to Thursday, July 2.
- Ramp closure northbound I-635 off ramp to Shawnee Drive and northbound on ramp from Shawnee Drive, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, June 30 to Thursday, July 2.

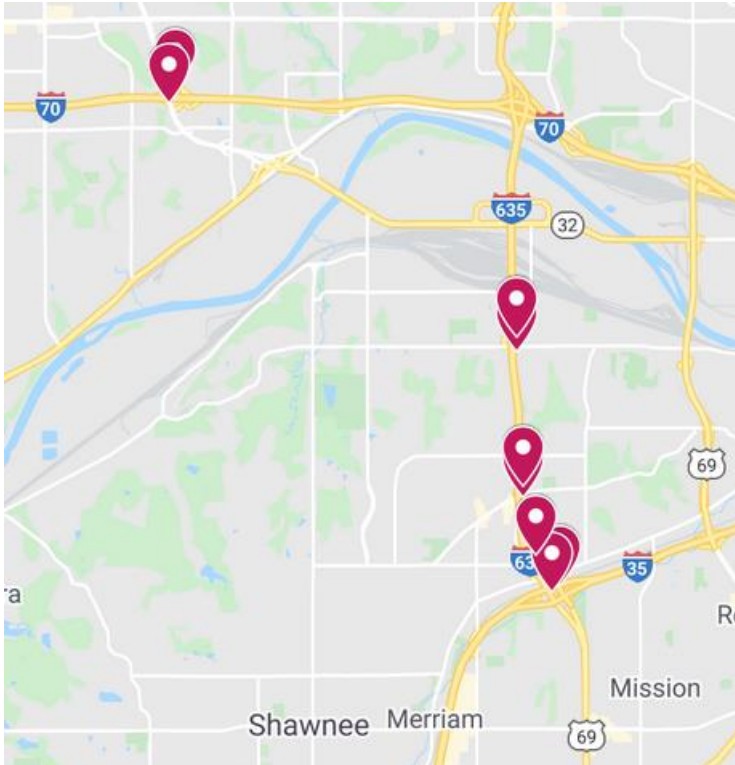
For grading work, the closures include:

- Ramp closure at southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70 and eastbound I-70 to southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., Friday, June 26, to Thursday, July 2. Work hours on Saturday, June 27 will be from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

For conduit work, the closures include:

- Left lane of southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway at I-70, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., Friday, June 26, and Monday, June 29 to Thursday, July 2.
