## Additional lane/ramp closures in Jefferson and Johnson counties

Lane and ramp closures are scheduled in Jefferson and Johnson counties, Monday, July 20 to Tuesday, July 21, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

Jefferson County –

For pavement marking, the closures include:

- Single lane closure on U.S. 59, from K-4 moving south. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, July 21. Traffic control will include a pilot car operation.

Johnson County -


For asphalt milling and overlay, the closures include:

For KC Scout camera work, the closures include:

- Right lane of southbound I-35 at Southwest Boulevard will be closed intermittently and the northbound I-35 on ramp from Lamar Avenue will be closed intermittently, Tuesday, July 21, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
