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Bridge joint replacement on I-635 in Wyandotte County begins July 6

A bridge joint replacement project on I-635, in Wyandotte County, to begin at 7 p.m., Monday, July 6, weather permitting. The bridge is located over the Burlington Northern Santa Fe railyard located between Kansas Avenue and Swartz Road in Kansas City.

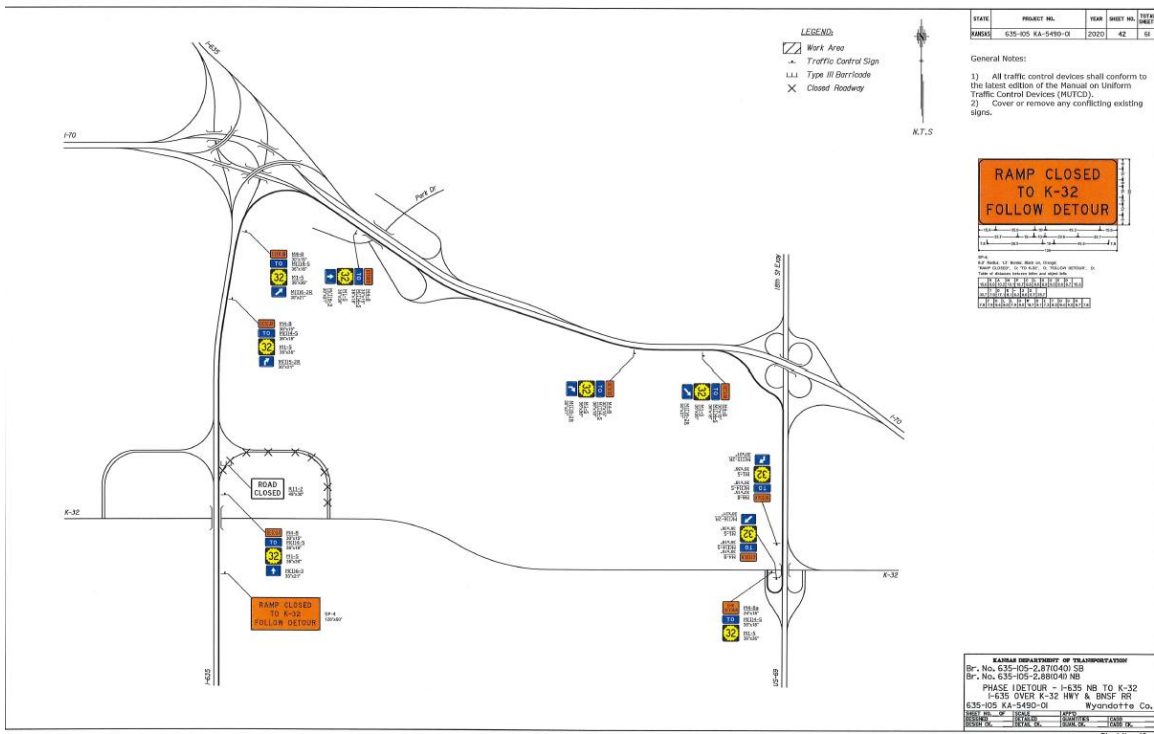
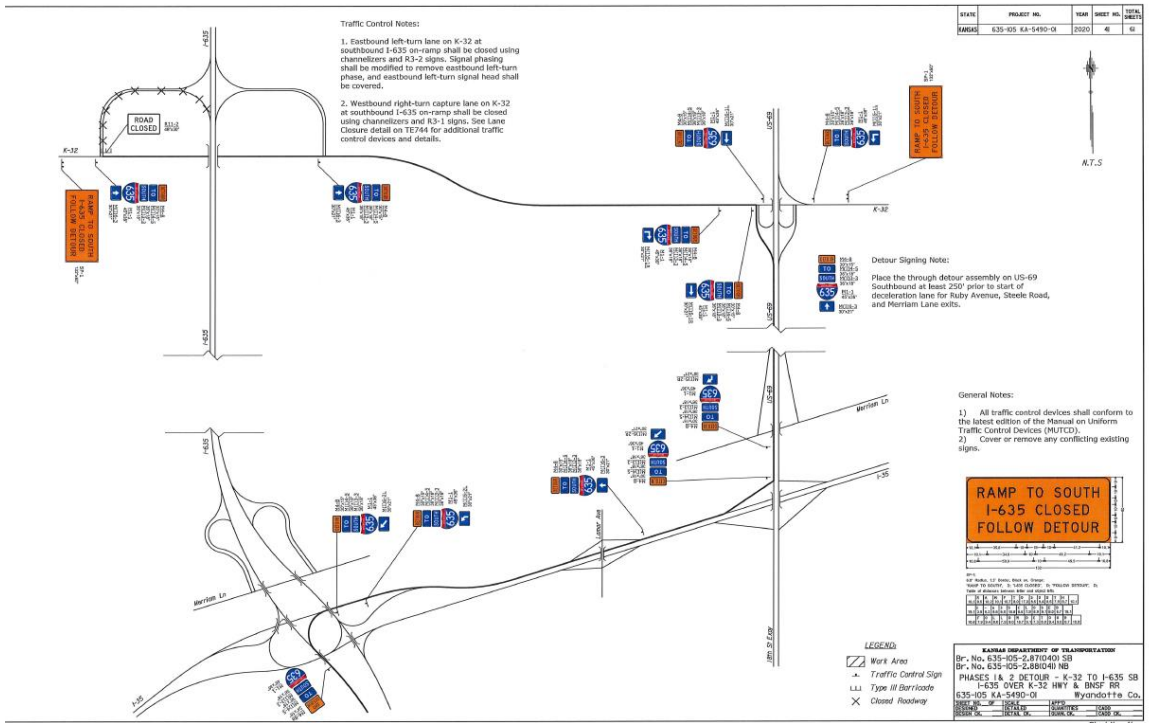
Regular work hours will be 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, and Saturdays, as needed. Project is expected to be completed in late November.

Drivers will be restricted to two lanes northbound and southbound, and lane width will be restricted to 11 to 12 feet. Traffic will be controlled using signage, detour signage and traffic cones.

The exit ramp from northbound I-635 to K-32/Kansas Avenue and the on ramp from K-32/Kansas Avenue to southbound I-635 will be closed for the duration of the project. See map below for alternative detour routes.

Superior Bowen Asphalt Co. of Kansas City, Mo is the contractor and Comanche Construction of Olathe is the subcontractor on the \$1.7 million project.
