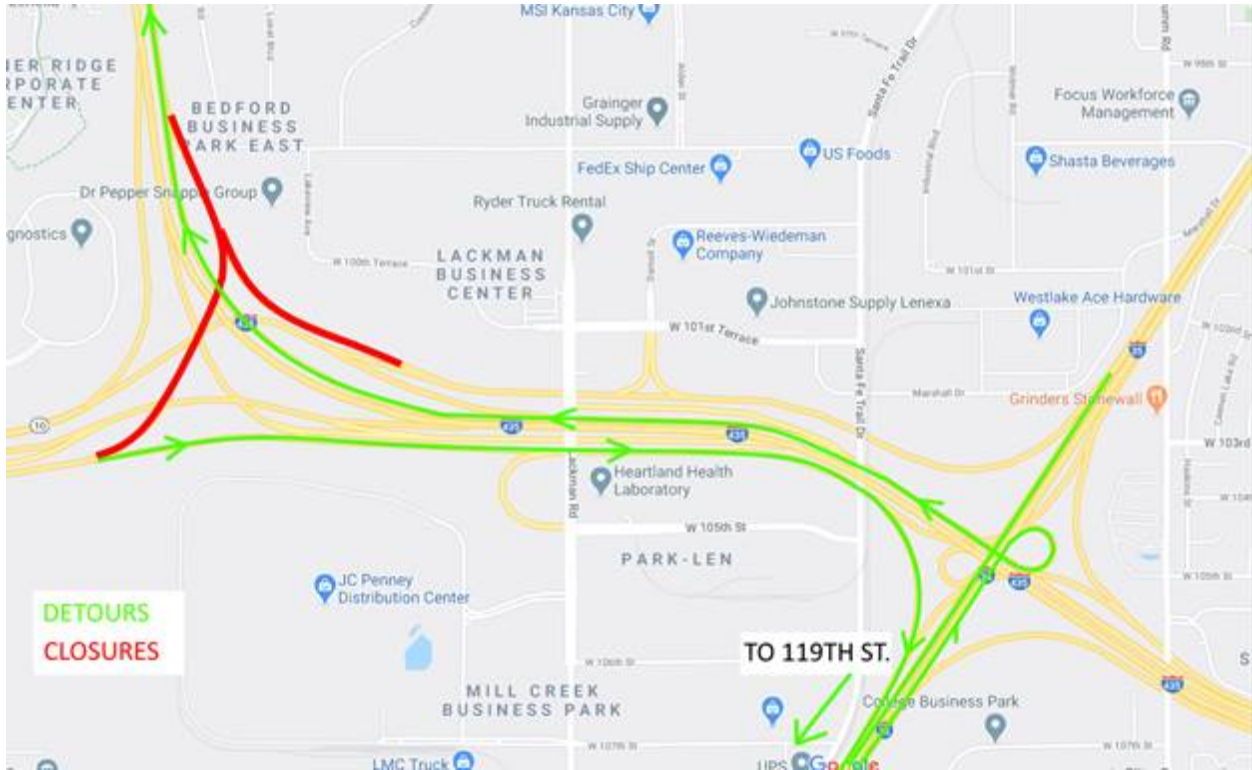
## **I-435 lane, ramp closures rescheduled for tonight in JOCO**

Lane and ramp closures on I-435 as well as on K-10 in Johnson County **were postponed last night and are scheduled to take place tonight, July 15**, for ongoing reconstruction work underway in the area, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

From 7 p.m. tonight to 6 a.m. Thursday, the following closures will take place:

- **Eastbound K-10 to northbound I-435 will be closed.** Traffic will detour on eastbound K-10 and southbound I-35, exit at 119<sup>th</sup> Street, go north on I-35 and take westbound/northbound I-435.
- **Northbound I-435 ramp from westbound I-435/westbound K-10 spur from I-35 will be closed.** Traffic will detour on southbound I-35, exit at 119<sup>th</sup> Street and take northbound I-35 to westbound/northbound I-435.
- **Southbound I-435** – two right lanes closed from 79<sup>th</sup> Street to K-10.
- **Northbound I-435** – two right lanes closed from K-10 to Midland Drive. The northbound on and off ramps at 95<sup>th</sup> Street and 87<sup>th</sup> Street will be intermittently closed, but not at the same time.

These detours and lane reductions could take several minutes. Motorists are encouraged to add extra time to their travel schedules or use alternate routes.
