**Lane closures, Jefferson, Leavenworth and Wyandotte counties**

Additional lane closures are scheduled in Jefferson and Wyandotte counties, Saturday, July 25 to Saturday, August 1, weather permitting. Traffic on these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

**Jefferson County –**

For pavement marking, the closures include:

- Single lane closure on U.S. 59, from Hickory Point Road moving north to the K-4. Work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturday, July 25. Traffic control will include a pilot car operation.

**Wyandotte County –**

For pavement sawing, the closures include:

- Two left lanes eastbound I-70, from Turner Diagonal Freeway to 65<sup>th</sup> Street,
- Two left lanes westbound I-70, from 65<sup>th</sup> Street to Turner Diagonal Freeway, Saturday, July 25, from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

For pavement patching, the closures include:

- Single lane and double lane as needed, westbound I-70, on the Mill Street Bridge, Monday, July 27 to Saturday, August 1. Will occur from Monday to Thursday, 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. and Friday to Saturday, 7 p.m. to 8 a.m.

**Leavenworth and Wyandotte County -**

For pavement bump grinding and pavement striping, closures include:

- One lane northbound and southbound U.S. 73 from State Avenue in Kansas City to Ida Street in Lansing, Monday, July 27 to Saturday, August 1, from 6 p.m. to 8 a.m.
