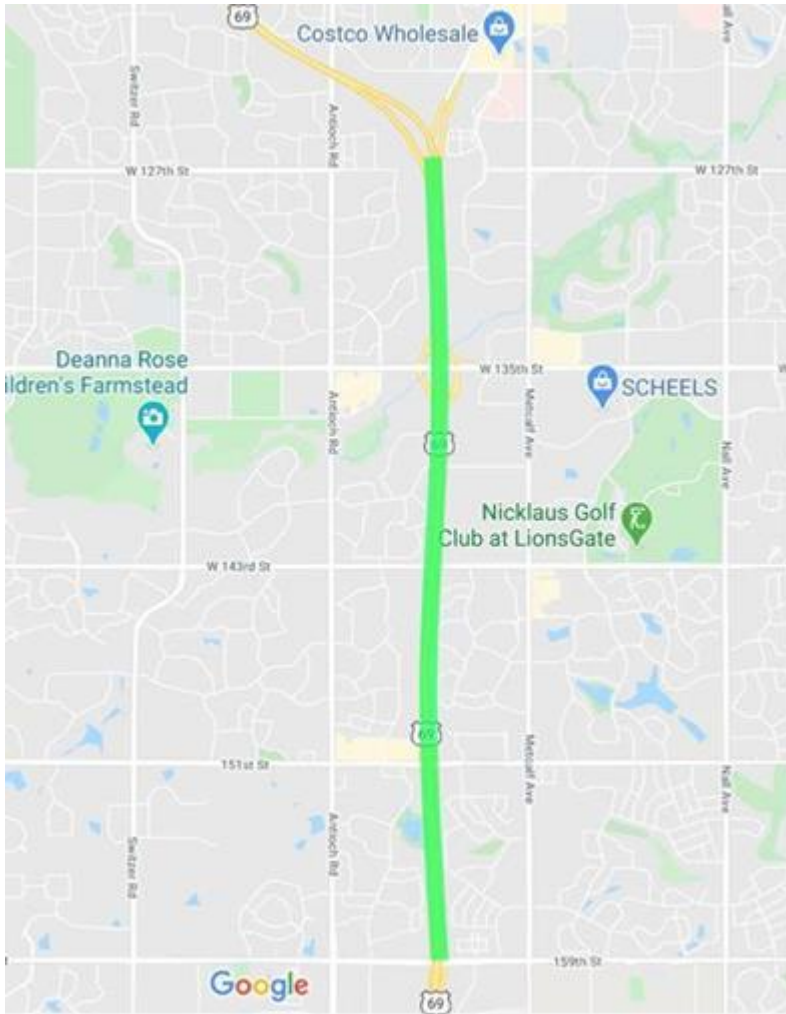
Lane closures on U.S. 69 in Johnson County to begin tomorrow

Northbound and southbound U.S. 69 will have intermittent left lane closures for shoulder treatment, from 159th Street to Blue Valley Parkway, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. Work will begin Thursday, May 21, and is expected to be completed, Monday, May 25, weather permitting.

Shoulder treatment consists of applying a sealant to the road shoulders. Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Traffic will be controlled by traffic cones and digital message boards.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
