## Lane and ramp closures in Johnson and Wyandotte counties

Lane and ramp closures are scheduled in Johnson County, Tuesday, July 28 and Wednesday, July 29, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

#### Johnson County -

For pavement patching, closures include:

Two right lanes, southbound I-435, from 79<sup>th</sup> Street to K-10, the on ramp at 95<sup>th</sup> Street, and off ramp from 87<sup>th</sup> Street, and the exit ramp to westbound K-10, from Tuesday, 7 p.m. to Wednesday, 6 a.m. A message board will instruct westbound K-10 traffic to use the Lackman Road exit to turn around.

For the addition of new shoulder grading material, closures include:

- Two right lanes, northbound I-435, from K-10 to Midland Drive, - Intermittent ramp closures, one at a time, at 95th Street, 87th Street and Midland Drive, from Tuesday, 7 p.m. to Wednesday, 6 a.m.

### For asphalt milling and overlay, closures include:

- Northbound and southbound K-7, intermittent lane and ramp closures, from K-10 to the Kansas River, Tuesday, 7 p.m. to Wednesday, 6 a.m.


#### Wyandotte County -

For KC Scout camera work, closures include:

- Right lane as needed, westbound I-70 at I-635,
- Ramp, as needed, eastbound I-70 to northbound I-635, Wednesday, July 29, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

These detours and lane reductions could take several minutes. Motorists are encouraged to add extra time to their travel schedules or use alternate routes.
