UPDATE--

Lane and ramp closures at Lewis and Clark Viaduct Bridge this week

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, eastbound I-70 will have intermittent lane and ramp closures this week to unload bridge girders onto a trestle in the Missouri River as part of the Lewis and Clark Viaduct Bridge project. Each I-70 closure could last for approximately 15-20 minutes. This project is rescheduled from last week.

Work will occur on Wednesday, June 3, and Friday, June 5. Two girders will be placed each day from approximately 2 p.m. to 4 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be stopped on eastbound I-70 and several on-ramps to unload each girder. The following ramps will be temporarily closed; Fairfax Trafficway to eastbound I-70, Washington Boulevard, Minnesota Avenue and eastbound I-70.

Traffic will be controlled using construction trucks and digital message boards. An additional two days will be scheduled to finish unloading bridge girders, at a later date.
