

Lane closed on K-10 at Lexington Avenue in Johnson County today

The left lane of eastbound K-10, from Lexington Avenue to the Kill Creek Bridge, is closed for bridge barrier maintenance. Work on the bridge is expected to begin today, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and completed, Wednesday, May 20, weather permitting.

Traffic will be controlled by traffic cones and digital message boards.
