Lane closure updates in Johnson County June 15 and June 16

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, lane closures on several projects will occur, Monday, June 15 and Tuesday, June 16, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects may be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

For asphalt mill and overlay, closures include:

- Right lane closed on southbound K-7, from Shawnee Mission Parkway to Prairie Star Parkway, June 15, from 7 p.m. to 9 a.m.
- Right lane closed on southbound K-7, from Prairie Star Parkway to K-10, June 16, from 7 p.m. to 9 a.m.

For concrete pavement patching, closures include:

- Left two lanes closed on northbound I-435 from K-10 to Midland Drive, June 15 and June 16, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

For bridge girder painting, closures include:

- Two right lanes closed on southbound I-35 at 67th Street and the on-ramp from 67th Street to southbound I-35, June 15 and June 16 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.


For guardrail maintenance, closures include:

- Left lane closed on westbound K-10 from Kill Creek Road to Lexington Avenue, June 16 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

For pothole patching, closures include:

- Alternating lane closures on northbound and southbound I-35 from I-435 to the Missouri State Line, June 15 and June 16, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
