**Lanes closed on I-35 at Mission Road this week**

The left two lanes of northbound and southbound I-35 at the Mission Road exit will be closed on Thursday, May 7 and Friday, May 8 for power line work, weather permitting. Work will occur from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

On Thursday, May 7 at approximately 10:30 a.m. and again at approximately 2 p.m., all lanes on I-35 will be closed for three minutes using rolling roadblocks. The Kansas Highway Patrol will be assisting with the rolling roadblocks.

Traffic will be controlled by using KC Scout message boards, arrow boards and traffic cones.
