## Maintenance projects on I-35 and K-10 in Johnson County this week


According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, pothole patching on northbound and southbound I-35, from the Missouri state line to I-435, will continue and is expected to be complete, Wednesday, May 27, weather permitting.

Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and traffic will be controlled by alternating mobile lane closures using trucks with arrow boards and digital message boards.

In addition, the right lane of eastbound K-10 will be closed for guardrail maintenance from the Douglas County line to Evening Star Road, Thursday, May 21 to Friday, May 22.

Work will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and traffic will be controlled with traffic cones and signage.
