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Mill and asphalt overlay on I-435 in Wyandotte County to begin July 18


A mill and asphalt overlay project on northbound and southbound I-435 in Wyandotte County, to begin, Saturday, July 18, weather permitting. Work will occur from the north bridge approach of the Kansas River, north to mile marker 16, about one-half mile north of Leavenworth Road. The project is expected to be completed by the end of October.

Work hours will be Monday to Friday, 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. and on Saturday and Sunday, 7 p.m. to 8 a.m. The first three to four weeks of the project will include asphalt and concrete patching before the overlay.

Traffic will be controlled with intermittent lane and ramp closures, lane width restrictions, flashing arrow boards, traffic cones and signage. Motorists should expect travel delays.

Koss Construction Co., of Topeka is the contractor on the \$8.4 million project.
