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
Mill and overlay on U.S. 69 ramps in Johnson County to begin Friday

A mill and overlay project on U.S. 69 ramps in Johnson County, is expected to begin, Friday, May 29 at 7 p.m., weather permitting. Work will occur overnight, on the ramps at Metcalf Lane, West Frontage, Barkley Street and West 56th Street. The project is expected to be completed by 3 p.m., Saturday, May 30.

Traffic will be controlled with lane and ramp closures as necessary, flashing arrow boards, traffic cones and signage. Motorists should expect travel delays.

Superior Bowen of Kansas City, Mo. is the contractor on the \$250,000 project.
