**Mill and overlay on U.S. 73 in Wyandotte and Leavenworth counties**

A mill and overlay project on U.S. 73 in Wyandotte and Leavenworth counties, is expected to begin, Monday, June 1, weather permitting. Work will occur from just north of State Avenue, north to Seven Mile Creek in Lansing. The project is expected to be complete in late August.

The first phase of this project includes two to three weeks of pavement patching and pavement marking on the south side of the northbound lanes. Mill and overlay will follow during the second phase.

Traffic will be controlled with daily lane and ramp closures as necessary, lane width restrictions, flashing arrow boards, traffic cones and signage. Flaggers will be used at intersections as needed. Motorists should expect travel delays.

Superior Bowen of Kansas City, Mo. is the contractor on the \$3.6 million project.
