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Mill and overlay project in Jefferson County to begin Tuesday

A mill and overlay project on K-92 and on U.S. 59 in Jefferson County, will begin, Tuesday, May 19, weather permitting. Work will occur in Oskaloosa on K-92 from Union Street to Liberty Street and from Delaware Street to the U.S. 59 junction, also on U.S. 59 from the south city limits of Oskaloosa north to the K-4 junction. The project is expected to be complete in late July.

Traffic will be controlled with daily lane closures as necessary, lane width restrictions, traffic cones and signage. A pilot car operation will be utilized to guide traffic through the work zone during working hours. Motorists should expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Herzog Contracting Corporation of St. Joseph, Mo is the contractor on the \$3.1 million project.
