Eastbound and westbound U.S. 56, from the west city limits of Gardner east to the I-35 bridge. Work is ongoing and complete, Thursday, April 2.


Northbound and southbound I-435 from the Kansas River to K-10 is expected to begin Friday, April 3 and complete, Friday, April 10.
