**Ramp and lane closures in Wyandotte County tomorrow**

Ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Wyandotte County, Thursday, May 28, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

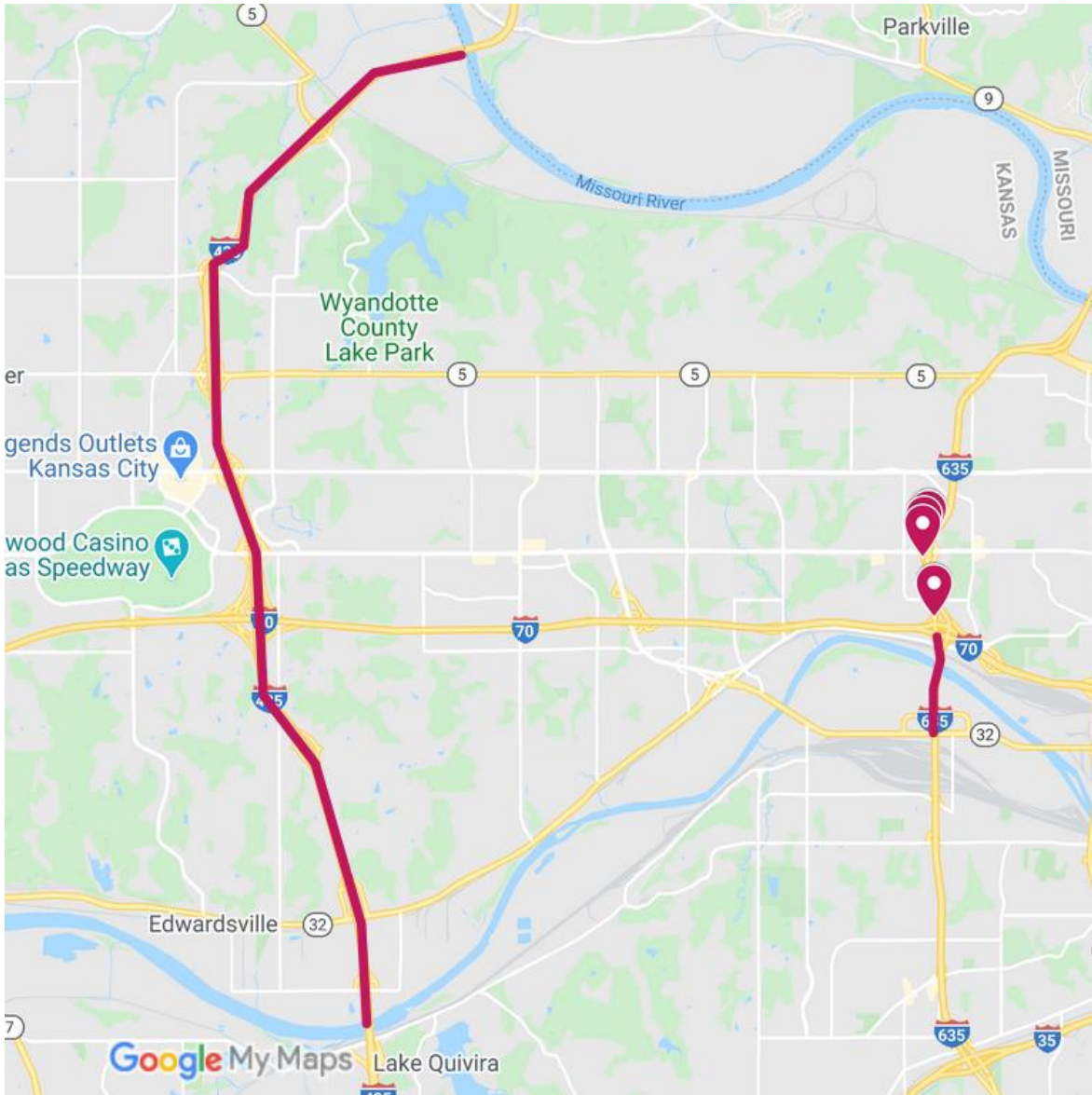
For pothole patching, closures include:

- Intermittent lane closures on northbound and southbound I-435, from the Kansas River to the Missouri River, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

To install pavement markings, the closures include:

- The single right lane of southbound I-635 from 43<sup>rd</sup> Street to K-32, from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. And the following ramps will close at 8:30 a.m.
- Southbound I-635 to State Avenue,
- Eastbound State Avenue to southbound I-635,
- Westbound State Avenue to southbound I-635,
- Southbound I-635 to westbound I-70.
