## **Ramp and lane closures in Wyandotte County tomorrow**

Ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Wyandotte County, Tuesday, June 2, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

For pothole patching, closures include:

- Right lane closure on northbound and southbound I-435, from the Kansas River to the Missouri River, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. This is an ongoing project extended to June 2.

To install pavement markings, the closures include:

- The single right lanes of northbound I-635, from Kansas Avenue to 43<sup>rd</sup> Street and eastbound I-70, from Quarry Road to 18<sup>th</sup> Street, from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. And the following ramps will close at 8:30 a.m.
- Northbound I-635 to K-32,
- K-32 to northbound I-635,
- Northbound I-635 to eastbound I-70,
- Westbound I-70 to northbound I-635,
- Northbound I-635 to State Avenue,
- State Avenue to northbound I-635,
- Eastbound I-70 to southbound I-635.

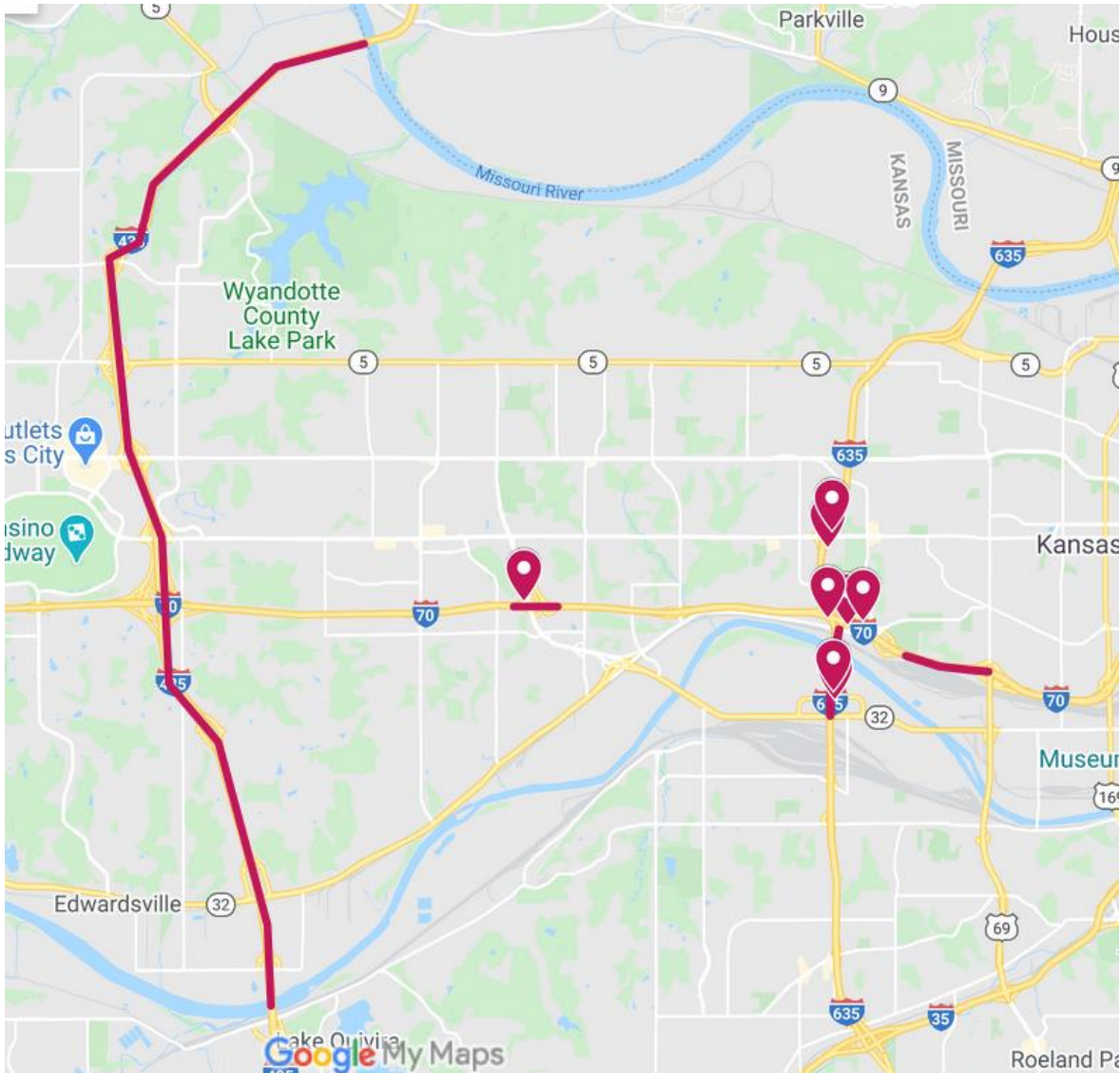
For grading work, the closures include:

- Ramp closure at southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

For Kansas Turnpike Authority maintenance work, the closures include:

- The left lane of westbound I-70 at the Turner Diagonal Freeway, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
