Ramp and lane closures in Wyandotte and Jefferson counties

Ramp and lane closures are scheduled in Wyandotte and Jefferson counties, Saturday, June 6 and Monday, June 8, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

Wyandotte County -

For pothole patching, closures include:

- Alternating lane closures on northbound and southbound I-435, from the Kansas River to the Missouri River, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, June 8.

For grading work, the closures include:

- The following ramps will close from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday, June 6.
 - Southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70,
 - Eastbound I-70 to southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway.
- The following ramps will close from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, June 8.
 - Southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70,
 - Eastbound I-70 to southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway.

For barrier wall maintenance work, the closures include:


- Alternating lane closures on eastbound and westbound I-70 from 61st Street to Rock Quarry Bridge, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, June 8.

Jefferson County –


For pavement overlay, the closures include:
