Turner Diagonal Freeway ramp and lane closures next week

The Turner Diagonal Freeway project in Wyandotte County, has numerous ramp and lane closures scheduled next week, Monday, July 6 to Friday, July 10, weather permitting. Traffic on all these projects will be diverted using mobile lane closures, signage and traffic cones.

For grading work, the closures include:

- Ramp closure at southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70 and eastbound I-70 to southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 6, to Thursday, July 9.

For conduit work, the closures include:

- Left lane of northbound and southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway over I-70, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 6 and Tuesday, July 7.

For barrier work, the closures include:

- Right lane of eastbound and westbound I-70 at the Turner Diagonal Freeway, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., Friday, July 10.

For sign truss removal, the closures include:

- Left lane westbound I-70 at the Turner Diagonal Freeway,
- Right lane eastbound I-70 at the Turner Diagonal Freeway,
- Left lane northbound Turner Diagonal Freeway at I-70,
- Left lane southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway at I-70.

Work will occur from 7 p.m. to midnight, Friday, July 10.

The following ramps will close at 6 a.m., Friday, July 10 to September 8.

- Eastbound I-70 to southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway,
- Eastbound I-70 to northbound Turner Diagonal Freeway,
- Northbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70,
- Southbound Turner Diagonal Freeway to westbound I-70.
